#### Goose Island Beer 312 Urban Wheat Ale

Pale Wheat Ale - American / 4.2% ABV / Chicago, IL

Inspired by the city of Chicago and densely populated with flavor, 312's spicy aroma of Cascade hops is followed by a crisp, fruity ale flavor delivered in a smooth, creamy body that's immensely refreshing.

#### Goose Island Beer Bourbon County Brand Stout (2018) 14.7%

Stout - American Imperial / 14.7% ABV / Chicago, IL

Brewed in honour of the 1000th batch at our original Clybourn brewpub. A liquid as dark and dense as a black hole with thick foam the color of a bourbon barrel. The nose is an intense mix of charred oak, chocolate, vanilla, caramel and smoke. One sip has more flavor than your average case of beer.

#### Goose Island Beer Brasserie Blanc

765ml Bottle £24.00

Golden Ale / 8.6% ABV / Chicago, IL

A golden ale aged in wine barrels with Orange Muscat grape juice, Brasserie Blanc has an aroma of semi-sweet Muscat grapes and a delicate body. A touch of tartness is cut by a dry finish imparted by the yeast *Brettanomyces*, resulting in a flavor profile that is reminiscent of wild-fermented old-world ales.

#### Goose Island Beer Cooper Project No. 3

Porter - Imperial / 8.3% ABV / Chicago, IL

This Barrel-Aged Porter, starts life as a rich porter brewed with chocolate malts and spices that is then barrel-aged for 3 months in fresh bourbon barrels.

Our India Pale Ale recalls a time when ales shipped from England to India were highly hopped to preserve their distinct taste during the long journey. The result is a hop lover's dream with a fruity aroma, set off by a dry malt middle, and long hop finish.

#### Goose Island Beer Halia

Saison / 7.5% ABV / Chicago, IL

Halia is a farmhouse ale aged in wine barrels with whole peaches, resulting in bright, effervescent fruit notes in a soft, hazy body that finishes slightly tart and sweet. Literally meaning "remembrance of a loved one" in Hawaiian, Halia was brewed in memory of the dear friend of one of our brewers who loved peaches.

The aroma is elegant, spicy and slightly roasted; a sophisticated blend of special malts give the beer a complex character, combining a delicate dryness with hints of coriander, dark fruits, anise and roasted chestnuts. The palate finishes in a syrupy taste.

Expect masses of tropical fruits bursting from the can as hops and yeast dance to create a sensual panoply of aromas. Oats lend a luxurious mouthfeel and low bitterness helps to accentuate this beer into a long and juicy finish.
